

FAQs

Q: What is this event all about?

Ans: As the name Crime Scene Investigation suggests this is about solving crimes. There will be unsolved cases, you as a team will have to unravel the mysteries using your detective skills.

Q: Is the event like a treasure hunt?

Ans: No, but the on the spot (physical) rounds have time constraints to crack clues that keep you on your feet.

Q: How to participate?

Ans: Form a group of four, register online, solve the online questionnaire and submit it before the deadline. Selection will be intimidated by mail.

Q: What is the selection process in online round?

Ans: Groups will be selected based on how many questions they solved correctly. If there is a tie, the preference will be given to team depending on the accuracy of the answers.

Q: How many rounds are there?

Ans: There will be two rounds in all - the online questionnaire and two field rounds. Details will be announced later.

Q: Do we need to remember any part of the online questionnaire for final round?

Ans: No. The field rounds will have their own story.

Q: Is there any time constraint?

Ans: Yes. Online-questionnaire has its own deadline (30th January, 2018 11:59 p.m.) Other rounds will have time limits as well, details regarding which will be given during the event.

Q: Are there provisions for on the spot registration?

Ans: No. There is no wildcard entry.

Q: Do we have to stay overnight?

Ans: Yes. You will have to if you live far. The event lasts for 2 days at IISER-K.

Q: Will accommodation be provided?
